Handicapping System for 2011 - For Competitions within the VCGC Only

Dear Members,

At our last Executive meeting, the VCGC Committee unanimously voted to establish a Tournament / Handicap Point System for our members this season. This system has already been adopted by approximately 500 golf clubs in order to make tournaments **fair and equitable** to all players.

This point system insures that all competitors are competing on a more equal basis by using past performances. If all golfers are abiding by the score posting guidelines established by the RCGA Handicap System, then each competitor should have the same chance as the next to win in tournaments. The point system is based upon awarding points to the best NET finishers in the Club's scheduled tournaments. Your own RCGA Handicap Index is not changed; however, affected players will compete in club tournaments at a reduced handicap based on past performance. We will be using the **four latest tournament scores** to determine total Points – this will constantly change throughout the season as the new score is added while the oldest score is removed.

Handicap reduction for our tournament competition will be as follows:

The club will determine the median score based on the whole field's results. (In the usual scenario, it will equal 72, but it may be lower depending on the difficulty of the course and overall results).



Handicapping System for 2011 - For Competitions within the VCGC Only

Anyone three under par (-3) will receive 1 point; Anyone four under par (-4) will receive 2 points;

Anyone five under par (-5) will receive 3 points; Anyone six under par (-6) will receive 4 points; and

Anyone seven under par (-7) or greater will receive 5 points.

When total points accumulated reach 6 - tournament handicap reduces by 1

When total points accumulated reach 8 - tournament handicap reduces by 2

When total points accumulated reach 10 - tournament handicap reduces by 3

Therefore, for Tournament 3 (June 2010):

Golfer 1 has 9 points in consecutive tournaments, and therefore will have an adjusted handicap in this tournament of -2. (i.e. go from 18 to 16)

Golfer 4 has 7 points in consecutive tournaments, and therefore will have an adjusted handicap in this tournament of -1. (i.e. go from 22 to 21)

Golfers 2, 3 and 5 did not place in Tournament 2 and therefore will not have any adjustment.

Golfer 4 placed again in tournament 3 and now has a total of 9 points in consecutive tournaments, and therefore will have an adjusted handicap in the next tournament of -2. (i.e. go from 22 to 20)

Golfer 1 also added 1 point and now has a total of 10 points in consecutive tournaments, and therefore will have an adjusted handicap in the next tournament of -3. (i.e. go from 18 to 15)

In tournament 4, the overall scores were higher, so there would be only two adjustments in this example – the two golfers that netted 64 and 69. However they do not have any previous points so no adjustment is made for these two golfers at this time.

** As mentioned above, only <u>the last four tournaments</u> will count towards the upcoming tournament; when we add the results for tournament 5 - we will drop tournament 1 from the calculation.

Calcutta:

We will apply this point system for all tournaments through the year except the Calcutta tournament in the team format for the following reasons:

1. Calcutta being played in a team format in such fashion that to have an individual player's handicap adjusted will compromise the fairness of others in the same team.

2. Handicaps of all players are recognized prior to the auction of each team, so it is fair to all bidders or the eventual owner of any team.

3. A player does not win the Calcutta event on his/her own merit.
